CHINESE DELEGATION ENJOYS IGEM WELCOME







IGEM HEADQUARTERS threw open its doors to welcome a delegation of members from the Far East District Section (FEDS).

More than 20 visitors from Hong Kong and China visited IGEM House as part of a trip taking in several sites of technical interest.

The delegation included a number of Chinese Industrial Affiliates, who

travelled to the UK with the aim of enhancing communication between the gas industries of the East and West.

The first stop on the UK visit was a trip to Fusion Group headquarters in Chesterfield, where the delegation was greeted by Group Managing Director Neil Green, before taking a tour of Fusion's manufacturing and testing facilities.

Next on the itinerary was a trip to global quality assurance and risk management company DNV GL's Loughborough site. A guided tour of DNV GL's laboratories took in materials and corrosion testing, gas quality research, plus advanced repair technologies.

After a busy morning, the group was greeted at IGEM House by CEO Neil Atkinson and Honorary Secretary Gordon Davies ahead of a buffet lunch.

Once their bellies were full, it was time to move next door for a chat with some of IGEM's UK Industrial Affiliates.

Here, they were treated to demonstrations from the likes of innovation firm Synthotech and virtual reality specialists Weldability Sif, plus a chat with representatives from ALH Systems, HWM, Inficon, Steve Vick International, and Sustainable Pipeline Systems.

Next, they sat down for some short presentations from CEO Neil, Head of Product and Market Development Simon Trollope and Head of Membership Claire McHugh. Simon briefed the delegates on IGEM standards work, plus some of the hydrogen and gas quality projects in which the Institution is playing a key role, while Claire explained the benefits of professional registration for gas engineers and managers.



Section Chair Eddie Pak, IGEM Vice President Duncan Wong and Past Chair Martin Kee thanked Neil and Gordon for IGEM's hospitality before the exchange of souvenirs marking the visit. Each of the delegates was also gifted a copy of IGEM's 150th anniversary book, signed by author Professor Geoff Lloyd.

The next day, the group had the

chance to explore Advanced Plasma Power's BioSNG plant, in Swindon. Aided by Ofgem funding, this plant is attempting to demonstrate the potential for renewable gas made from domestic and commercial waste.

Later, IGEM FEDS expressed its sincere gratitude to IGEM and all the organisations that assisted with a successful and productive visit.
